(To be recited after Fajr)

Ayat al-Kursi (Surah Al-Bagarah 2:255)

Arabic:

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَٰهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ ۚ لَا تَأْخُذُهُ سِنَةٌ وَلَا نَوْمٌ ۚ لَهُ مَا فِي السَّمَاوَاتِ وَمَا فِي الْأَرْضِ ۗمَن ذَا الَّذِي يَشْفَعُ عِندَهُ إِلَّا بِإِذْنِهِ ۚ يَعْلَمُ مَا بَيْنَ أَيْدِيهِمْ وَمَا خَلْفَهُمْ ۖ وَلَا يُخِيطُونَ بِشَيْءٍ مِّنْ عِلْمِهِ إِلَّا بِمَا شَاءَ ۚ وَسِعَ كُرْسِيُّهُ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضَ ۖ وَلَا يَئُودُهُ حِفْظُهُمَا ۚ وَهُوَ الْعَلَىٰ ُ الْعَظيمُ

Transliteration:

Allāhu lā ilāha illā huwa al-ḥayyul-qayyūm. Lā ta'khudhuhu sinatun wa lā nawm. Lahu mā fī as-samāwāti wa mā fī al-arḍ. Man dhā alladhī yashfa'u 'indahu illā bi-idhnih. Ya'lamu mā bayna aydīhim wa mā khalfahum, wa lā yuḥīṭūna bishay'in min 'ilmihi illā bimā shā'. Wasi'a kursiyyuhu as-samāwāti wa al-arḍ. Wa lā ya'ūdū ḥifẓuhumā, wa huwa al-'aliyyu al-'azīm.

Translation:

Allah – there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, the Sustainer of existence. Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. Who is it that can intercede with Him except by His permission? He knows what is before them and what will be after them, and they encompass not a thing of His knowledge except for what He wills. His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and their preservation tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Most Great.

Surah Al-Ikhlas (x3)

Arabic:

قُلْ هُوَ اُللَّهُ أَحَدٌ اُللَّهُ اُلصَّمَدُ لَمْ يَلِدْ وَلَمْ يُولَدْ وَلَمْ يَكُن لَّهُ كُفُوًا أَحَدٌ

Transliteration:

Qul huwa Allahu aḥad, Allāhuṣ-ṣamad, Lam yalid wa lam yūlad, Wa lam yakun lahu kufuwan aḥad.

Translation:

Say, "He is Allah, [who is] One,
Allah, the Eternal Refuge.
He neither begets nor is born,
Nor is there to Him any equivalent."

Surah Al-Falaq (x3)

Arabic:

قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ ٱلْفَلَقِ مِن شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ وَمِن شَرِّ غَاسِقٍ إِذَا وَقَبَ وَمِن شَرِّ ٱلنَّقُّثُتِ فِى ٱلْعُقَدِ وَمِن شَرِّ حَاسِدٍ إِذَا حَسَدَ وَمِن شَرِّ حَاسِدٍ إِذَا حَسَدَ

Transliteration:

Qul a'ūdhu birabbil-falaq, Min sharri mā khalaq, Wa min sharri ghāsiqin idhā waqab, Wa min sharri an-naffāthāti fīl-'uqad, Wa min sharri hāsidin idhā hasad.

Translation:

Say, "I seek refuge in the Lord of daybreak
From the evil of that which He created
And from the evil of darkness when it settles
And from the evil of the blowers in knots
And from the evil of an envier when he envies."

Surah An-Nas (x3)

Arabic:

قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ ٱلنَّاسِ مَلِكِ ٱلنَّاسِ إِلَٰهِ ٱلنَّاسِ مِن شَرِّ ٱلْوَسْوَاسِ ٱلْخَنَّاسِ مَن شَرِّ ٱلْوَسْوَاسِ ٱلْخَنَّاسِ ٱلَّذِى يُوَسْوِسُ فِى صُدُورِ ٱلنَّاسِ مِنَ ٱلْجِنَّةِ وَٱلنَّاسِ

Transliteration:

Qul a'ūdhu birabbin-nās,

Malikin-nās,

Ilāhin-nās,

Min sharri al-waswāsil-khannās,

Alladhī yuwaswisu fī şudūrin-nās,

Mina al-jinnati wa al-nās.

Translation:

Say, "I seek refuge in the Lord of mankind,

The Sovereign of mankind,

The God of mankind,

From the evil of the retreating whisperer

Who whispers [evil] into the breasts of mankind

From among jinn and mankind."

"SubhanAllah wa bihamdihi" (100 times)

Arabic:

سُبْحَانَ ٱللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ

Transliteration:

Subḥānallāhi wa biḥamdihī

Translation:

Glory is to Allah and praise is to Him.

"La ilaha illa Allah, wahdahu la sharika lahu..." (x10 or x100)

Arabic:

لَا إِلٰهَ إِلَّا ٱللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ ٱلْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ ٱلْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَىٰ كُلّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Transliteration:

Lā ilāha illa Allāh, waḥdahu lā sharīka lah, lahul-mulku wa lahul-ḥamdu wa huwa 'alā kulli shay'in qadīr.

Translation:

There is no deity but Allah, alone without partner. To Him belongs the dominion and to Him belongs all praise, and He is over all things competent.

"Astaghfirullah" (x100)

Arabic:

أَسْتَغْفرُ ٱللَّهَ

Transliteration:

Astaghfirullāh

Translation:

I seek forgiveness from Allah.

Evening Adhkar

(To be recited after Asr or Maghrib)

Repeat the same adhkar as the morning

Du'a for Protection from Harm

Arabic:

َ اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْهَمِّ وَالْحَزَنِ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْعَجْزِ وَالْكَسَلِ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْجُبْنِ وَالْبُخْلِ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ غَلَبَةِ الدَّيْنِ وَقَهْرِ الرّجَالِ

Transliteration:

Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-hammi wal-ḥazan, wa a'udhu bika minal-'ajzi wal-kasal, wa a'udhu bika minal-jubni wal-bukhl, wa a'udhu bika min ghalabatid-dayni wa qahrir-rijal.

Translation:

O Allah, I seek refuge in You from anxiety and sorrow, from weakness and laziness, from cowardice and stinginess, and from the burden of debts and being overpowered by men.

Du'a for Peaceful Sleep and Protection at Night

Arabic:

بِاسْمِكَ رَبِّي وَضَعْتُ جَنْبِي، وَبِكَ أَرْفَعُهُ، فَإِنْ أَمْسَكْتَ نَفْسِي فَاغْفِرْ لَهَا، وَإِنْ أَرْسَلْتَهَا فَاحْفَظْهَا بِمَا تَحْفَظُ بِهِ عِبَادَكَ الصَّالِحِينَ

Transliteration:

Bismika Rabbi waḍa'tu janbi, wa bika arfa'uhu, fa in amsakta nafsī faghfir lahā, wa in arsaltahā faḥfazhā bimā taḥfazu bihi 'ibādaka aṣ-ṣāliḥīn.

Translation:

In Your name, O Lord, I lay down my side, and by You I lift it. If You take my soul, forgive it. If You return it, protect it in the way You protect Your righteous servants.

Du'a for Forgiveness and Mercy

Arabic:

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ، وَأَنَا عَلَىٰ عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ، أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ، وَأَبُوءُ لَكَ بِذَنْبِي، فَاغْفِرْ لِي، فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Transliteration:

Allahumma anta Rabbi, la ilaha illa anta, khalaqtani wa ana 'abduka, wa ana 'ala 'ahdika wa wa'dika ma istata'tu, a'udhu bika min sharri ma sana'tu, abu'u laka bini'matika 'alayya, wa abu'u laka bidhanbi, faghfir li, fa innahu la yaghfiru adh-dhunuba illa anta.

Translation:

O Allah, You are my Lord, there is no deity but You. You created me and I am Your servant, and I abide by Your covenant and promise as best I can. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I acknowledge Your favor upon me and I acknowledge my sin, so forgive me, for surely none forgives sins except You.

- Wipes away sins and increases reward
